





- On 6/19/2023, DBME started receiving claims for replacement of stolen benefits as a result of electronic theft, known as EBT Skimming.

- EBT Skimming Monthly Preliminary Data: Between 2/1/2024 and 2/29/2024, 107 SNAP claims were approved for an issued amount of \$37,527.


- EBT Skimming Quarterly Final Data: In Q1 (October 2023 - December 2023), 1,091 SNAP claims were approved for an issued amount of \$479,249.



1 Year Sparkline Population Trend




**Tuberculosis Control


