



CBC QUICK SETUP

The main landing page to get started with the CBC is located at: https://cbc.az.gov/. **Note:** The CBC also has a mobile phone view.

STEP 1: CREATE AN ACCOUNT

Recommended to Watch Video 1: Create Account and Login - Individual on the https://des.az.gov/CBC.

Note: If you completed your fingerprint clearance card application electronically, you do not need to create an account. Login to: cbc.az.gov. Your DPS Portal is linked to the CBC Portal.

- 1. Select 'Individual/Personal'
- Create your account following the screen prompts

STEP 2: SUBMIT A BACKGROUND CHECK REQUEST

Recommended to Watch Video 3: Submit an Employment Request - Individual on the https://des.az.gov/CBC.

- 1. Login to https://cbc.az.gov/
- 2. Select Employment
- 3. Enter Employer email address of: _____
- 4. Does your background check require a Fingerprint Clearance Card?
 - Select 'No' if you do not already have a Fingerprint Clearance Card.
 - Select 'Yes' if you have a Fingerprint Clearance Card already.

Note* A fingerprint clearance card is required but will be obtained at a later date.

- Ensure both Department of Child Safety (DCS) Check and Arizona Adult Protective Services (APS) Check are selected before you agree to terms and continue.
- 6. Date Employed: ______ You may enter this if you know the date you started, if not skip this
- 7. Enter the Solicitation Number, Contract Number, or Provider ID: ______
- 8. Verify and complete the remainder questions as prompted on the screen
- 9. Complete Signature screen: Note your name MUST match as entered on your account set up.
- 10. Submit

STEP 3: GET BACKGROUND CHECK RESULTS

When the background check results are available, the CBC sends an email indicating a notification is available. Login to the CBC and click 'Dashboard' in the upper right header. The 'Recent Notifications' section lists all of your unread messages.
