**Social Services Block Grants (SSBG) Tribal Allocations
for SFY-2013**

This ALERT identifies the estimated local planned SSBG Tribal allocations for SFY 2013. Attached are the allocations for each tribe for the period of July 1, 2012-June 30, 2013.

The Department prepares the SSBG plan based on the best official funding level information from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) at the time the plan is developed. The State of Arizona's allotment of the national SSBG appropriation is determined by DHHS based on the portion of the national population that resides in Arizona. Due to a shift in the national population, there was a reduction in Arizona's share of the national SSBG allocation. This reduction impacts the funding available for locally planned SSBG services in SFY 2013. Therefore there is an estimated reduction of approximately 3.6 percent for locally planned services for SFY 2013. The initial allocations listed below include the 3.6 percent reduction.
