AM I ELIGIBLE FOR THE HILTON HONORS MILITARY PROGRAM?

To be eligible for the Hilton Honors Military Program, a person must:

- Have served in the US Armed Forces for at least 180 days and have been discharged or released under conditions other than dishonorable. Active service includes full-time duty in the National Guard or a Reserve component
- Be a resident of or reside in Arizona or moving to Arizona from a state that does not offer the Hilton Honors program
- Provide a copy of a valid DD214 or if on active duty a copy of an active military ID card
- Complete a full registration on the Arizona Job Connection website (azjobconnection.gov)
- Have active job search activity and be "work ready"
- Be required to travel over 50 miles from their current residence to participate in an employment activity
- Create a Hilton Honors account at JoinHonors.com
- Have a valid e-mail address
