What is the Restaurant Meals Program?

The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) includes a Restaurant Meals Program that allows persons with disabilities, the elderly, and homeless SNAP households to use their QUEST (EBT) cards to purchase meals from participating restaurants and retailers. EBT cards work similar to ATM and credit cards.

This program benefits Arizona's large population of elderly and persons with disabilities who may have difficulty preparing meals for themselves. It also allows homeless households the opportunity to purchase meals if they do not have a place to store and cook food.
