Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) Client Waitlists

As a result of decreased funding and increased demand, many Area Agencies on Aging have waitlists for HCBS. These waitlists were discussed at the September 2014 meeting with the Area Agency on Aging leadership. In an effort to ensure understanding of the processes applied by each agency to collect waitlist information, the Division of Aging and Adult Services (DAAS) is requesting that each Area Agency on Aging e-mail to Mark Radan at mradan@azdes.gov by November 15, 2014 their methodology describing the following:

- process used to track service availability,
- process used to place a client on the waitlist (multiple services or single service),
- process used to prioritize client, if applicable,
- length of time a client remains on the waitlists,
- process for client follow-up, and
- process to remove client from the waitlist and reasons for removal.

The Division of Aging and Adult Services Reporting System (DAARS) has the capability to generate monthly waitlist reports. Area Agencies on Aging will be requested to submit explanations to DAAS when fluctuations occur within their waitlists.

State Health Insurance Assistance Program (SHIP)/Senior Medicare Patrol (SMP) for SFY-2015

State Health Insurance Assistance Program (SHIP)

Previously, ALERT SFY-15-7, the Division of Aging and Adult Services (DAAS) allocated funding for SHIP on estimates based on a grant award in the amount of \$703,132 from the Administration for Community Living (ACL) for the grant term of April 1, 2014 - March 31, 2015 for the State Health Insurance Assistance Program (SHIP). The ACL has subsequently provided a supplement in the amount of \$91,844 for the original grant term. The adjusted total award amount is \$794,976.

Emphasis for this grant term will continue to focus on the following activities:

- 1. Enhancement and expansion of local program capacity to provide enrollment information, counseling, and assistance to reach and assist Medicare beneficiaries who:
 - Are disabled, specifically beneficiaries who are under 65 years old,
 - Are low income, especially those likely to be eligible, but who have not yet applied for Medicare Prescription Drug Low Income Subsidy (LIS), and/or
 - Speak languages other than English, have literacy challenges, and beneficiaries living in intensely urban or frontier rural areas.
- 2. Expansion of existing partnerships with other public and private organizations involved in providing outreach, counseling, and enrollment assistance.
- 3. Increase internet access to local counselors and local counseling sites.
- 4. Utilize SHIPTalk National Performance Report data system to demonstrate achievements in providing services to Medicare beneficiaries by established deadlines and in accordance with performance measures requirements.
- 5. Submit monthly reports that include: completed Public and Media forms, at least three case summaries, lessons learned, list of volunteers, and number of contacts.
- 6. Participate in CMS outreach events, by providing support for the CMS Regional Office community-based events.

The SHIP Grant terms and conditions require that five percent of the grant or \$35,157 be utilized to provide one-on-one pharmaceutical benefit counseling to dual eligible beneficiaries with mental illness for the following activities:

- Provide Medicare Part D training to case management staff with the AHCCCS's (Medicaid) Mental Health Division and/or local Regional Behavioral Health Authorities (RBHAs).
- Expand referral network with AHCCCS and/or RBHAs to identify the process used by case managers to refer the calls back to the SHIP Coordinator or complete the Client Contact Forms.

Health Education-Disease Prevention and Health Promotion Program

The Department of Economic Security, Division of Aging and Adult Services (DAAS), through the Arizona Department of Health Services (ADHS), received its third year grant award for Chronic Disease Self Management Education (CDSME) from the Administration for Community Living. The overall amount of the award is \$140,449. The grant period is **September 1, 2014 – August 31, 2015**. The goal of this grant is to increase the number of older adults and/or adults with disabilities in Arizona with chronic conditions who complete the Healthy Living, Chronic Disease Self-Management Program (CDSMP) and Diabetes Self-Management Program (DSMP) as well as expand integrated and sustainable services systems within Arizona.

There is no match required for this allocation.

The allocations included in the table below are intended to assist Area Agencies on Aging (AAAs) with participating in a collaborative process to support activities included in the CDSME grant project. These activities include increasing the delivery of Healthy Living, CDSMP and DSMP in Spanish and English.

Other Funds for SFY-2015

This ALERT applies to the Area Agency on Aging, Region One, Inc. (AAA R1) and the Pima Council on Aging (PCOA) for Elder Refugee Services.

The ALERT is being provided to non-participating regions as information only.

Project for Services to Older Refugees

The Division of Aging and Adult Services (DAAS) received a grant award from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Administration of Children and Families, Office of Refugee Resettlement (ORR), to continue the implementation of the Project for Services to Older Refugees. The Project for Services to Older Refugees covers a wide array of services to elder refugees, from English language training and United States citizenship preparation, to the adaptation of mainstream services to provide linguistically and culturally appropriate elder services. This ALERT represents the first installment or 58 percent of a total budget. The remaining balance will be added in at a later date subject to availability.

The AAA R1 will serve as the lead organization for Maricopa County. The Tucson International Alliance of Refugee Communities (TIARC) will serve as the lead organization for Project continuation in Pima County. Client specific information will not be entered into the Division of Aging and Adult Reporting System (DAARS). The PCOA will serve as the fiscal agent for funding between the Arizona Refugee Resettlement Program (RRP) and TIARC in Pima County. The scope of work prepared by the RRP should be included in the sub-contract with the TIARC. The RRP staff will continue to have direct oversight of TIARC and approval of expenditures prior to payments being made by PCOA. In addition, RRP staff will have direct oversight of the contract monitoring and related program performance activities of TIARC.

The contracts will be amended to add the following amount for the service of Program Development (PGD) which is available for the period of October 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015:
