SFY-12-1B

Title III and VII for SFY-2012

The Division of Aging and Adult Services (DAAS) received a decrease of \$359,465 for Older Americans Act Title III and Title VII collectively in the FFY 2011 grant awards from the Administration on Aging as identified in Alert SFY-12-1A issued on June 30, 2011. One-time allocations are being made in an effort to offset these reductions. The Division's administrative funds are being used to make these one-time allocations under the categories of Title III-C1, III-E, and VII.

Allocated funds are to be expended by June 30, 2012. These funds cannot be used for Administration.

Effective July 20, 2011, SB1082 authorized the Division of Aging and Adult Services (DAAS) to require all Contractors to obtain a fingerprint clearance card when providing direct service to DES clients. Employees who provide direct services that are hired after July 20, 2011 are required to obtain a fingerprint clearance card as a condition of their employment. Employees hired prior to July 20, 2011 have until December 31, 2012 to obtain a fingerprint clearance card. These requirements apply to volunteers who provide direct services to DES clients.

DAAS is allocating one-time funds to assist with the costs associated with processing fingerprint clearance cards for employees/volunteers who recently obtained a one-time background check. In addition, the fingerprint background checks process still has 377 applications that require some level of research. A one-time allocation is being made to allow Area Agencies on Aging to complete the research needed as part of their current process.

It is anticipated that Older Americans Act funds from Title III-C2 or Title III-B will be used for fingerprinting expenditures not related to the C1 program.

A program match of 15 percent is required for Title III allocations, except for Title III-E. AAAs are required to provide a 10 percent non-federal match for all services funded under an approved Area Plan on Aging for the cost of carrying out Older Americans Act programs. DAAS provides a 5 percent non-federal cash match to AAAs using State General Fund allocations identified for Independent Living Support services. This is also known as the "state" match.

The non-federal cash match funds have been identified separately from the federal allocation to assist AAAs with determining the required "state" match for services funded with Older Americans Act funds. If Older Americans Act funds are increased or decreased, the required match must be increased or decreased respectively. This also applies to carryover funds.

Non-federal program cash match from State General Fund – Independent Living Support, for Older Americans Act funding is based on the following formula:

(funds allocated) x (.055556) (.944444)

Tribal Area Agencies on Aging may combine Independent Living Support and State Administration in order to fulfill their match requirements.

Other Funds for SFY-2012

This ALERT applies to Area Agency on Aging (AAA), Region One, Inc.

This ALERT is being provided to non-participating regions as information only.

The Division of Aging and Adult Services (DAAS) received a grant award of \$57,904 for SFY 2011 from the Administration on Aging (AoA) for the Arizona Next Generation Performance Outcome Measurement Project (POMP). The collaborative POMP effort between the DAAS, Area Agency on Aging Region One, Inc. (AAA, Region One) and its contracted provider is known as AzPOMS. The award was announced in ALERT SFY-11-11J dated October 29, 2010. An allocation of \$53,440 was made to AAA, Region One, Inc. to conduct grant activities for the budget period August 1, 2010 through July 31, 2011. A total of \$5,900 in carryover funds exist for expenditures in SFY 2012.

DAAS has applied to the AoA for a no-cost extension to finish all grant activities. Grant activities are to be completed by August 31, 2011 and all related AAA, Region One charges are to be submitted to DAAS by September 16, 2011.

The grant agreement requires a 25 percent non-federal in-kind/cash match for the funding based on the following formula:

(AzPOMS funds allocated) x (.25) (.75)

Service code IA2 will continue to be used for Next Generation POMP.

Progress reports shall continue to be submitted bi-monthly to DAAS through AAA, Region One, Inc. by its subcontractor for the most recent reporting period. The due date for the final bi-monthly progress reports is due on or before October 5th. Reporting categories include activities, accomplishments, barriers, dissemination activities, technical assistance requested, and program successes/difficulties.

AAA, Region One, Inc. and/or its contracted provider shall continue to collaborate with national POMP workgroup members made up of other POMP grantees, the AoA, and its technical contractor to complete grant activities.

In addition, RRP staff will have direct oversight of the contract monitoring and related program performance activities of TIARC.
