The Problem

Responding to paper-based Unemployment Insurance (UI) information requests from state UI Agencies can create costly administrative burdens on employers and TPAs. The problem is further compounded when employer operations are located in multiple states, because no national standard has existed to help states and employers electronically exchange key information regarding UI claims, until now.

The Solution

SIDES and SIDES E-Response were developed through a strategic partnership between the U.S. Department of Labor and state UI agencies. These systems offer employers and TPAs a secure, electronic, and nationally standardized format to better anticipate and supply the data needed to respond to UI information requests, reduce follow-up phone calls, and streamline UI claim response processes.
